Tenterden Streetscape Masterplan

Whitelaw-Turkington are now in the final stages of completing their Streetscape Masterplan for Tenterden. This encompasses the High Street and Lanes from West Cross to the Fairings. It will analyse the streetscape of the town, including design, materials, furniture and signage and make costed recommendations for significant improvement in keeping with the important and sensitive fabric of the town. There are specific recommendations which they will be making for the coach park, Coombe Lane and part of Station Road which is an important point of arrival in the town, and which is currently unwelcoming, bleak and featureless.

The Masterplan will be the subject of a public presentation and consultation at the **Town Hall in Tenterden from 2pm to 8pm on Friday 8th June** and again from 10am to 6pm on Saturday 9th June. Lindsey Whitelaw, Managing Director of Whitelaw-Turkington, will be giving a formal presentation at 6pm on Friday 8th June.

We hope very much that you will be able to attend. If you are unable to come to the formal presentation at 6pm on the 8th, we hope that you will be able to visit at some other time on the Friday or Saturday. We are inviting comments to carry the process forward and would welcome what you have to say.
