Youth club hits at censorship

FILM censorship arrangements were attacked by members of Tenterden Youth Club on Sunday, when they discussed the ban on the film, *I, A Woman* by the borough council's general purposes committee.

The young people who attended the meeting were all over the age of 16, but they unanimously decided that the age of 16 as a dividing line in cinema audiences was wrong.

They felt that the case for a change in the law was furthered by the fact that it was habitually flouted by large numbers of people.

At the close of their discussion, the members decided on the retention of a film certification of an informatory, not mandatory nature, so that film-goers could have an unbiased indication of a film's nature.
