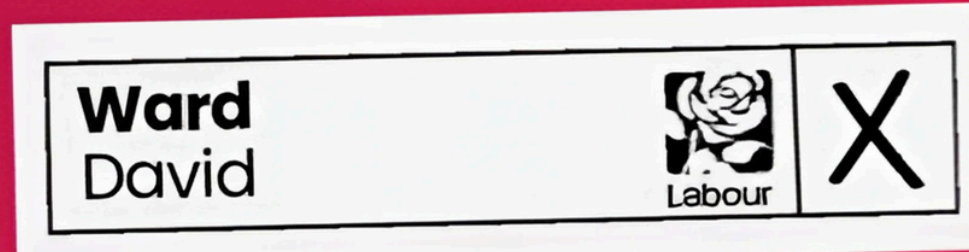

Voter ID is now required for UK elections. You will not be able to vote at the polling station on 1st May without certain forms of voter ID, eg: passport, drivers licence, older person's bus pass or if you have a Voter Authority Certificate (for which the application deadline is 5pm on Wednesday 23 April).
