Saturday 3rd July - Friday 16th July

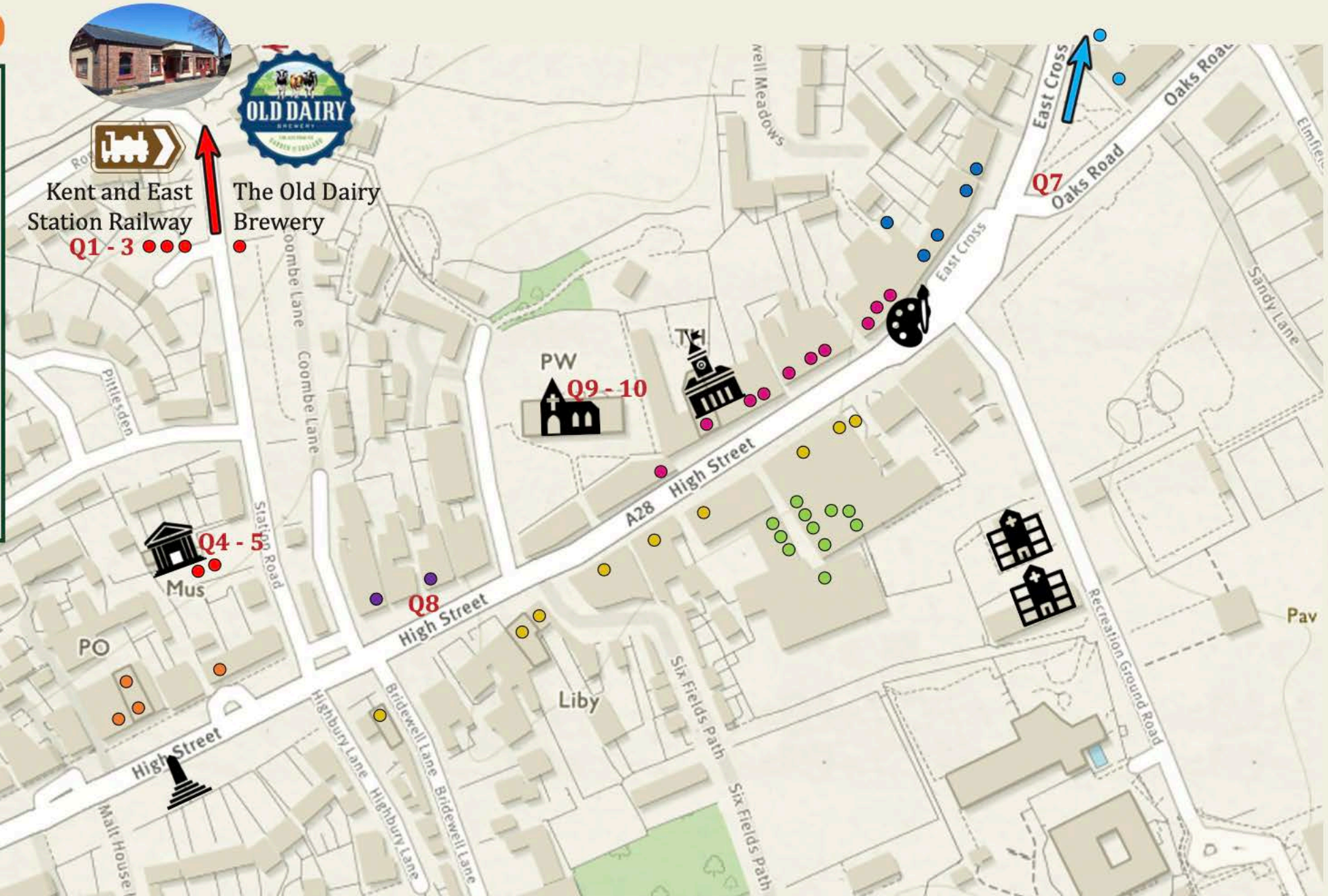
